Rules and Guidelines:**Eligibility**

This is open to any member (male or female) of the Diocese of Southwest America who belongs to a parish of the diocese. Applicants should be enrolled in an accredited college or university. The annual income of the applicant's family should be \$75,000 or less. Applications must be received on or before the submission deadline.

Late submissions and incomplete applications will not be accepted. Proof of income/church involvement will be verified with the help of the Vicar.

Evaluation and Selection

Applications will be evaluated based on need and merit by an MMVS Committee. Recommendations will be given to the Diocesan Bishop for a final decision.

Implementation

The scholarship will be disbursed by September 2023. Maximum scholarship available to an applicant is \$1,000. Support for future years is not guaranteed, but the applicant can reapply for the educational aid in future years if they successfully continue their program.
