## **Dearly Beloved in Christ,**

After Resurrection Sunday, the Holy Church eagerly awaits the feast of the Pentecost. The faithful anticipate the renewal of the Holy Spirit to empower and guide them in fulfilling their mission of the Church. As we serve the Church, we deeply appreciate your prayers and valuable contributions. We express our gratitude to all the members of the assembly, both the clergy and lay people, for their active participation and support in ensuring the success of the Diocesan Assembly 2024 held at Urshelm Aramana, the Diocesan Headquarters. We are confident that our continued partnership will bring greater positive change and impact to our Diocese.

As we bring into fruitfulness the mission of our diocese, the main source of income is the Diocesan Share. The generous support of every Church and its faithful members has been instrumental in the success of our diocese throughout all these years. As part of the collective decision upheld in the Diocesan Assembly 2024, the important updates are:

- 1. We shall remember the Holy Church and our Diocese in all our prayers that the name of the blessed Trinity is glorified at all times.
- 2. As part of the monetary collections required for the running of various spiritual and charitable organizations of the diocese, we kindly remind you that each parish has to fulfill the stipulated target which is set at the **Number of Families multiplied by \$100**.
- 3. Each parish is requested to send the required offerings **quarterly** and the whole amount to be disbursed to the diocesan office **on or before November 30**. Thus, all churches can be included in the annual report and discrepancies that arise out of late payment can be avoided.
- 4. The Diocesan Assembly decided and endorsed unanimously that every parish shall pay the Diocesan Share from the Church accounts and not wait for it to be collected from its parish members. The parish can take its own time to collect the Diocesan Share from its members for the year. This will reduce a considerable financial burden on the diocese.
- 5. ZELLE options for our banking purposes are rolled out. Church Donations like catholicate and diocesan share along with other donations (Seminary Day, Mission Sunday, Garbo Sunday, and Clergy Retirement Priest-Kohne Sunday offertory, etc.) can be sent via Zelle. The Zelle ID is dswa.catholicate.zelle@gmail.com.
